Orting School District (OSD) is the 93rd largest school district in Washington and includes four schools; two elementary schools, one middle school, and one high school. OSD is located 41 miles south of Seattle, 20 miles southeast of Tacoma, and 30 miles northwest of Mount Rainier. The district encompasses over 45 square miles of Orting and areas of Graham and Bonney Lake.
