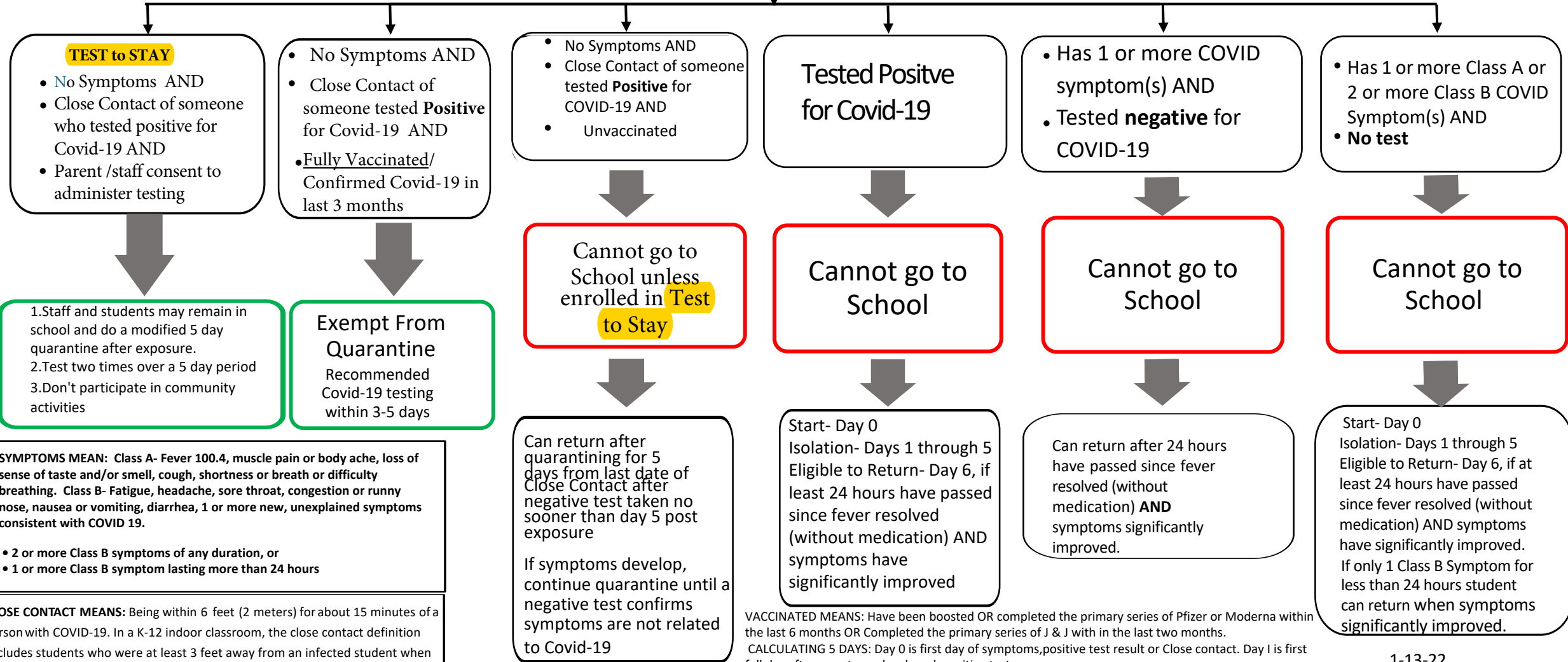


COVID-19 Response Flow Chart

Responding to Cases or Suspected Cases of COVID-19



SYMPTOMS MEAN: Class A- Fever 100.4, muscle pain or body ache, loss of sense of taste and/or smell, cough, shortness or breath or difficulty breathing. Class B- Fatigue, headache, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea, 1 or more new, unexplained symptoms consistent with COVID 19.

- 2 or more Class B symptoms of any duration, or
- 1 or more Class B symptom lasting more than 24 hours

CLOSE CONTACT MEANS: Being within 6 feet (2 meters) for about 15 minutes of a person with COVID-19. In a K-12 indoor classroom, the close contact definition excludes students who were at least 3 feet away from an infected student when both students are wearing masks, and other preventative measures are in place.

VACCINATED MEANS: Have been boosted OR completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna within the last 6 months OR Completed the primary series of J & J with in the last two months.
CALCULATING 5 DAYS: Day 0 is first day of symptoms, positive test result or Close contact. Day 1 is first full day after symptoms developed, positive test or exposure
