

COVID-19 Response Flow Chart

Responding to Cases or Suspected Cases of COVID-19

SYMPTOMS consistent with COVID-19

Class A

- Fever 100.4°F / 38°C or higher
- Cough
- Loss of sense of taste and/or smell
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing

Class B

- Fatigue
- Muscle pain or body aches
- Headache
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea (defined as 2 or more loose stool in 24 hours)
- 1 or more new, unexplained symptom consistent with Covid-19

- **SYMPTOMS MEAN:** Any Class A Symptom of any duration, or
- 2 or more Class B symptoms of any duration, or
- 1 or more Class B symptom lasting more than 24 hours

CLOSE CONTACT MEANS: Being within 6 feet (2 meters) for about 15 minutes of a person with COVID-19. In a K-12 indoor classroom, the close contact definition excludes students who were at least 3 feet away from an infected student when both students are wearing masks, and other preventative measures are in place.

- No Symptoms AND
- Close Contact of someone tested **Positive** for Covid-19 AND
- Fully Vaccinated/ Confirmed Covid-19 in last 3 months

Exempt From Quarantine
Covid-19 testing within 3-5 days

- No Symptoms Close
- Contact of someone tested **Positive** for COVID-19
- PCR Tested Negative

Cannot go to School

Can return after quarantining for 14 Days from last date of Close Contact OR Quarantine can end after 7 full days beginning after the last close contact. The PCR testing should occur no sooner than 48 hours before ending quarantine

- NO Symptoms
- Tested **Positive** for COVID-19

Cannot go to School

Can return after quarantining for 10 days since symptom onset or the positive test, AND 24 hours after fever resolves (without medication), AND without symptoms

- Has 1 or more COVID symptom(s)
- Tested **negative** for COVID-19

Cannot go to School

Can return after 24 hours have passed since fever resolved (without medication) **AND** symptoms have improved.

- Has 1 or more Class A or 2 or more Class B COVID Symptom(s)
- Tested **positive** or had **no test**

Cannot go to School

Can return 10 Days after symptoms started **AND** At least 24 hours have passed since fever resolved (without medication) **AND** Symptoms have improved. If only 1 Class B Symptom for less than 24 hours student can return without symptom OR a COVID Test
