Dear parent/Guardian:

Washington State Law demands strict control over the administration of *over-the-counter* or *prescription* medication taken during school hours. This includes **cough drops**.

Washington State Regulations **REQUIRE** written permission and directions from the **physician/dentist AND parent/guardian** for **ALL** medications given during school hours. **No exceptions.** 

We are not allowed to legally dispense medication and students are not allowed to have medication at school without the completed attached form.

Medications are generally kept in the health room, however, students carry some medications with health provider, parent, and district nurse approval. Examples of such medication are: Epi-Pen, inhalers, or insulin and supplies for diabetes.

We are **legally NOT** allowed to dispense medication of any kind from plastic sandwich bags, envelopes, or other containers.
